

Sepsis is the body's response to an infection. If you think you have an infection and develop any of the following symptoms you may have sepsis. **Dial 999** and **Just Ask: "Could it be Sepsis?"**

Slurred speech or confusion
Extrême shivering or muscle pain
Passing no urine (in a day)
Severe breathlessness
It feels like you're going to die
Skin mottled, discoloured or very pale

WHAT IS SEPSIS?

Sepsis is a life-threatening condition that arises when the body's response to an infection injures its own tissues and organs.

Sepsis can lead to shock, multiple organ failure and death especially if not recognised early and treated promptly.

HOW DO I SPOT IT?

Sepsis can initially look like other illnesses like 'flu or gastroenteritis and can be difficult to spot. There is no one sign, and symptoms can present differently in adults and children.
